## Ideas for Art at Home

Fourth Graders will soon be using scratch art to study Greek art and architecture. You can try making your own scratch art at home with just a few supplies and these simple steps. You will need:

- Heavy duty paper (oak tag or cardstock)
- Oil pastels
- Tempera Paint

- Dish Soap
- Paintbrush



1) Using your oil pastels, cover the surface of your paper with color. Make sure to create a heavy coat of oil pastel by pressing hard.





2) Pour a couple tablespoons of the tempera paint onto a plate or palette Add a couple drops of dish soap into it. Mix them together and then paint on top of the oil pastel using your paint/soap mixture. To cover the oil pastel you may need to let the first coat dru and then add another.

3) Draw out your design with a pencil, and then using a toothpick or a wooden stick, scratch away the paint to reveal the color underneath. Try using cross-hatching to enhance your drawing and add value!
